WSACC is committed to the implementation of an environmental, health and safety management system which will enable WSACC to operate the treatment and collection facilities in the most efficient and cost effective manner possible while minimizing impacts on the environment and limiting health and safety risks. In order to achieve these goals WSACC is committed to and will:

- **Comply** with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, statutes, and regulations as set forth in WSACC's existing and future permits, certifications, and other environmental, health and safety requirements to which WSACC subscribes;
- **Conserve** natural resources and prevent pollution by beneficially reusing and recycling materials, supplies, and resources while reducing wastes and minimizing the inefficient use of materials and resources;
- **Commit** to continual improvement of the EHSMS policies, procedures, and environmental performance, taking into account technical developments, regulatory promulgations, and community expectations. WSACC further commits to prevention of injury and ill health in the workplace. Goals and objectives will be established and the performance toward meeting them will be evaluated periodically.

WSACC employees are under a continuing obligation to evaluate, refine, and improve all aspects of this Policy. All employees and those persons working on behalf of WSACC are expected to comply with the spirit as well as the letter of this policy. Each employee, and those persons working on behalf of WSACC have been trained on and provided a copy of this Policy.
